- Q. Why might my toilet be running?
- A. A corroded flush valve assembly, overflow pipe, or simply a worn out flapper valve might be causing your toilet to run. Make sure to resolve this issue as soon as possible as this means that your toilet is leaking and is wasting tons of water.
- Q. How can I tell if my toilet is efficient?
- A. You can tell if your toilet is efficient through knowing the year it was made. Newer toilets made after 1994 use around 1.6 gallons per flush. Older toilets made before that use 3.5 gallons/flush.
- Q. What is the reason of my water coming out yellow?
- A. A common occurrence with water appearing yellow is a buildup of rust within your pipes.
- Q. What can be the root cause of the lack of hot water in my home?
- A. An aging water heater might be one cause of the lack of hot water in your home. Another cause might be a collection of sediment in your water heater. This can be avoided by emptying your water once a year.
- Q. I'd like to know why the water pressure in my home is weak.
- A. A weak water pressure is caused by a constrained pipe. Old pipes tend to rust over time and collect rust inside restricting the flow of water through them thus affecting your water pressure.
- Q: Is there something wrong with my dishwasher if it doesn't get rid of all the water after use?
- A: There is nothing wrong with your dishwasher if it leaves some water behind. The remaining water helps the correct temperature for the heating element so that it doesn't overheat. It might be of concern to you however if you notice that your dishwasher doesn't drain the water at all. This might be caused by a serious problem such as a clogged drain line.
